

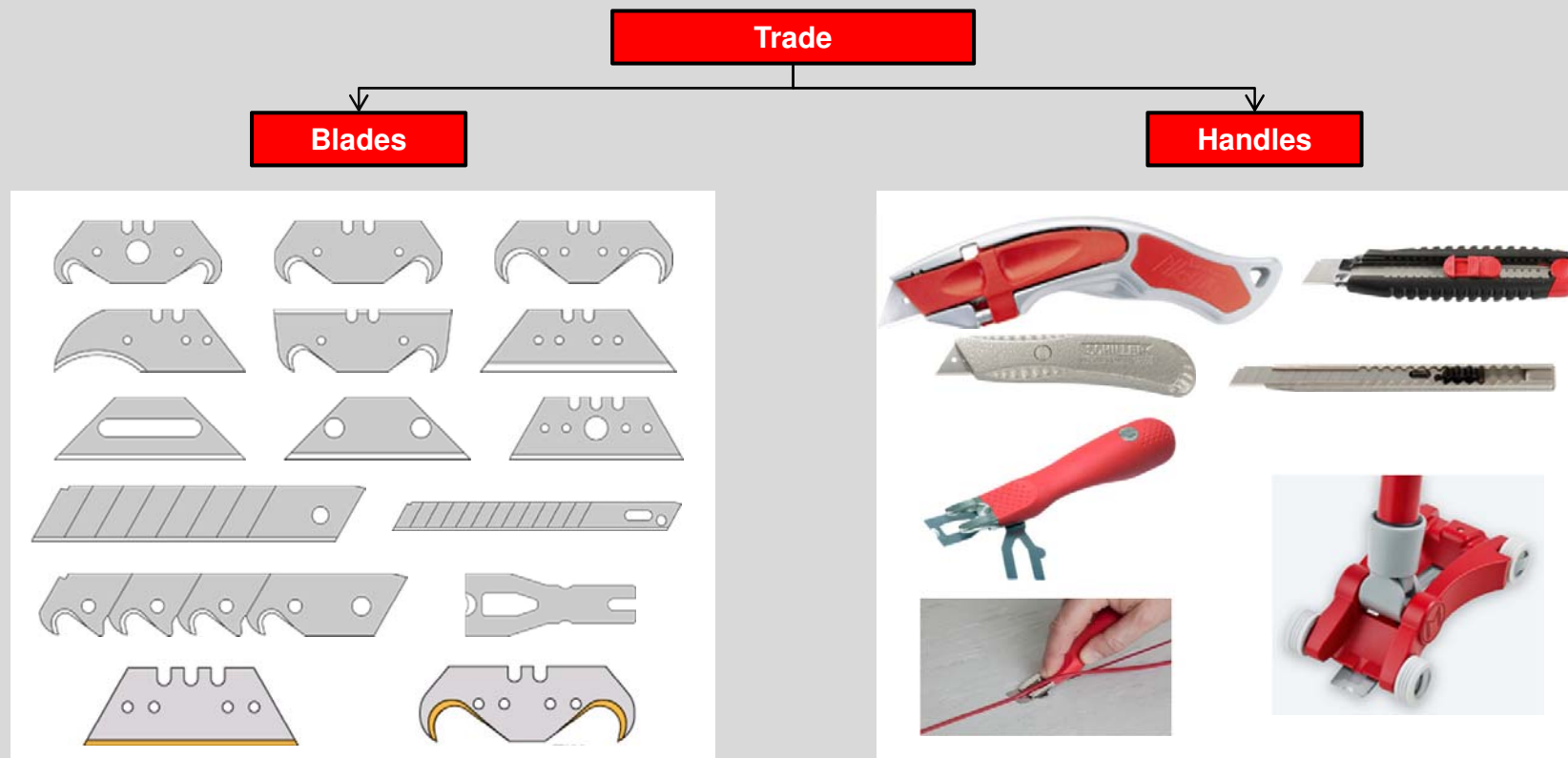

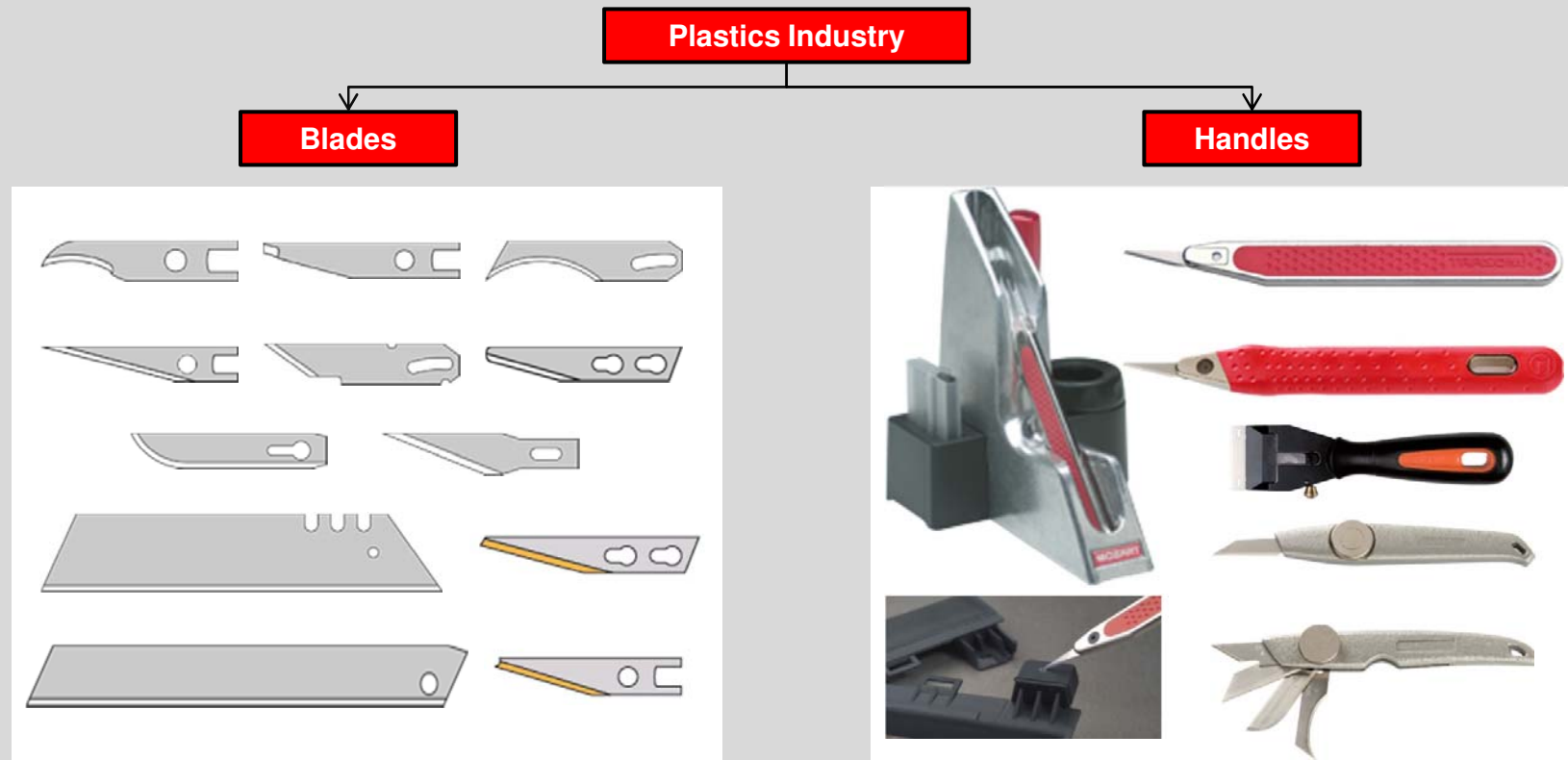

Deburring injection moulded parts, scraping or separating plastic parts, trimming hoses to length: for every application, you will find that MOZART has the ideal solution



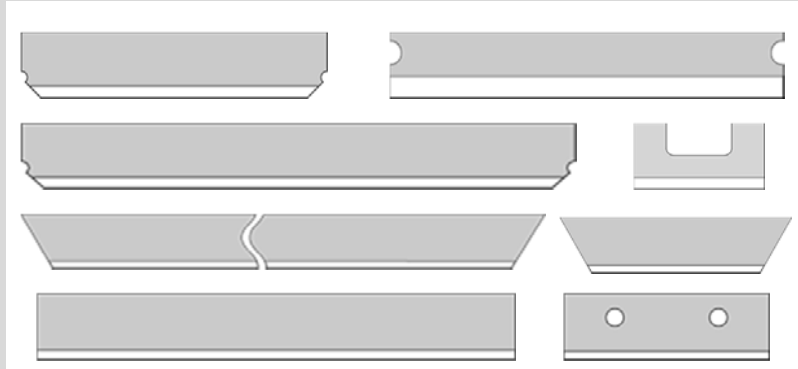
